We would like to introduce you to our new Y4 teacher Mr Carson, joining our staff team this year.

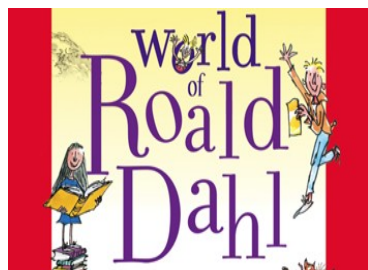


Mr Carson says he is very happy to join our school and has really enjoyed reading the children's creative writing.
