We had our first 'late door' of the year run by School Attendance Services today. Lateness changes everything! Did you know that?

- ★ Regular lateness disrupts pupil learning and their key skills.
- ★ Lateness means a child is playing catch up.
- Lateness can have an impact on the whole class
- * At the start of each day classes typically cover the building blocks for the rest of the day and beyond.
- Regular lateness can affect a child's self esteem and their confidence in school and education.
- Poor school attendance can lead to a variety of issues for a young person.
