### Positive Parenting-Triple P Parenting Course

The Triple P course is for parents who want to learn more on how to manage children's behaviour and for parents who are having real problems with children who constantly misbehave or to find out how to set up better routines for mealtimes and bedtimes.

Triple P is based on tried and tested methods that have been proven to work.

Triple P sessions are delivered by experienced parenting practitioners and are relaxed, informal, friendly and supportive.

The course runs for 6 weeks.

Triple P will take place at The Eden Children's Centre on our school site on Friday mornings 9.30-11.30 beginning on **Friday 9th November**.
