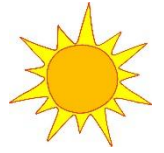


Year 1 Summer 2 Learning

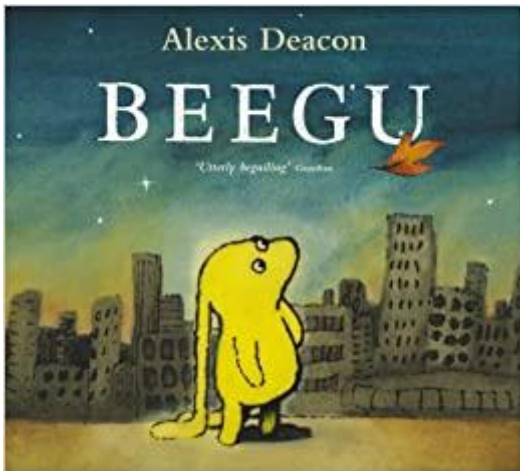

English



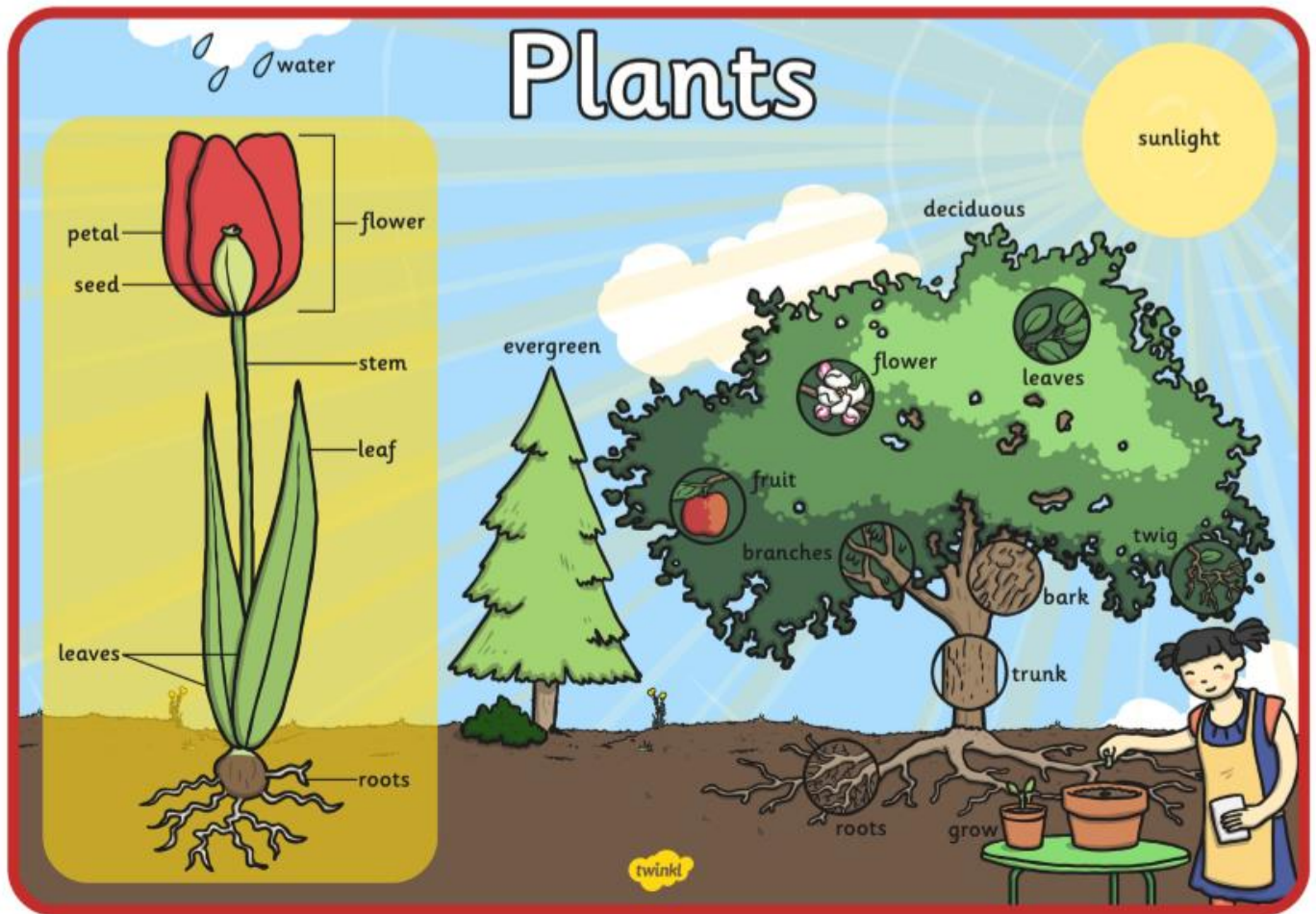
Our fiction book for this half term is BEEGU by Alexis Deacon. If you can read any extracts from it online or manage to get hold of a copy - it is a story about an alien that gets lost on planet earth and struggles to find help from humans. Discuss the story with the children and how they think Beegu feels. This could lead to the children writing

a letter of advice to Beegu.

Reading is a very important part of year 1 so please keep up reading regularly with your child. Enjoy reading some of their favourite books - fiction, non-fiction, poetry etc. Also, try and read a book by our class author, Oliver Jeffers.

Science



Our Science topic this half term is Plants. There are videos and images online that outline the anatomy of a plant and the process from a seed to a flower. If you can, have the children plant their own seeds either in a pot or in the garden and have the children monitor the growth of their plant. They could write a diary to detail the changes in their plant over 4 weeks.

Geography

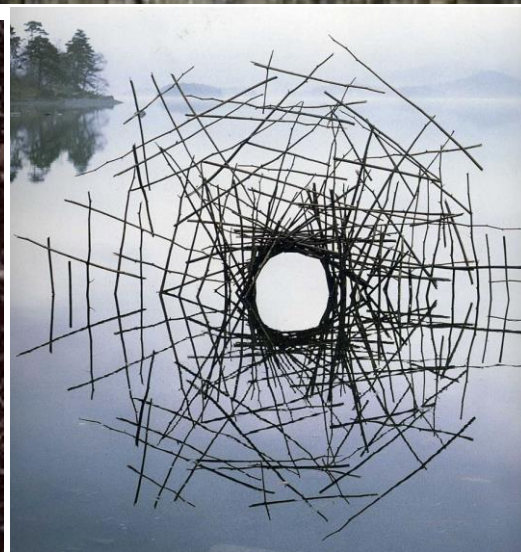


Our geography topic this half term is the Seaside. The children can research and discuss seaside towns in the UK and seaside towns in Spain and compare the differences. What is the weather like? What do people do at the seaside? The children can also research why seaside visits became popular in the UK during the Victorian times. Our class

trip this half term would have been a trip to Southport beach so if you can, take advantage of the nice weather and get down there!

Art

Our Art topic this half term is Andy Goldsworthy who is famous for making art using everyday materials. Below are a few examples of his work. See if the children can recreate and sketch some of the examples provided below.



Music

The children can listen and appraise music by our class composers: Abba and Vivaldi. The children can discuss what they can hear and what the music reminds them of. How does it make them feel? Can they clap along to the beat?

PE

Our PE this half term is catching and throwing games. The children can work on their catching and throwing skills outdoors with different sized and weighted balls and objects. The children should practise stepping into their throws and different types of throws such as underarm and overarm.
