"How lucky I am to have something that makes saying goodbye so hard."



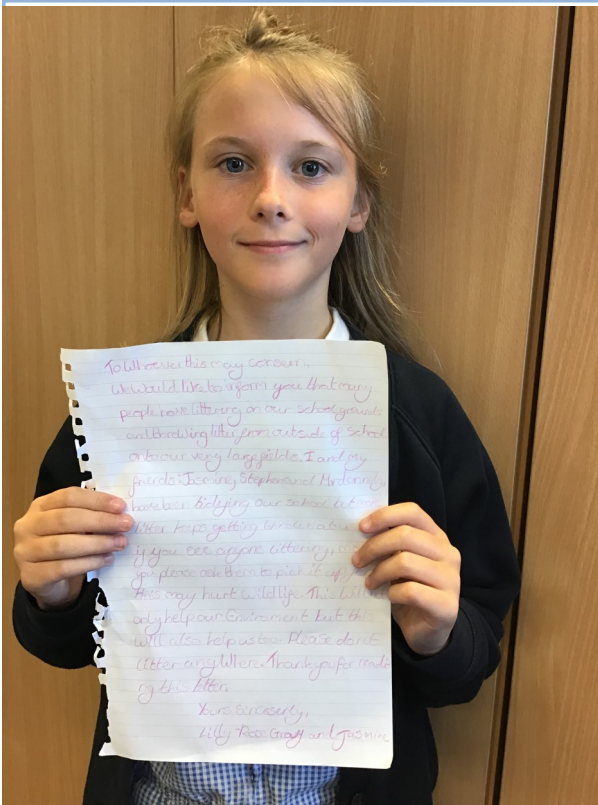
Key Stage 2 Chinese Culture Day

Lina has started to harvest some of our strawberries. If the sun continues to shine then we should have a bumper crop!

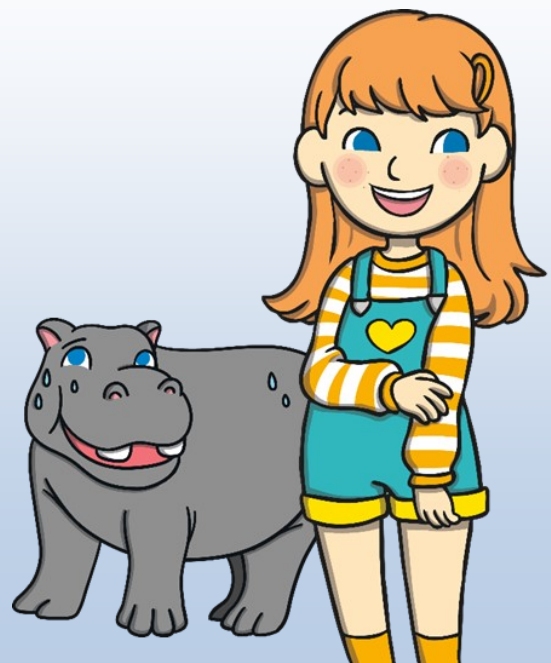
The Hope-o-potamus
