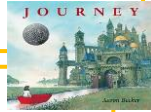


English:

History:

This half term, Year 3 children will explore the impact of the Roman Empire on Britain. They'll investigate Emperor Claudius' invasion, compare Roman settlements with Celtic villages, learn about Boudicca's rebellion, and explore the final years of Roman rule. Through this study, they'll gain insights into how the Romans influenced Britain's culture, society, and history.

Maths:

This term in Maths, Year 3 will explore mass, capacity, length, and time. Through hands-on activities, they'll learn to measure and compare these quantities, applying their skills to real-life situations.

Art: Abstract shape & space

This unit focuses on teaching pupils how to transform 2D card shapes into three-dimensional structures and sculptures. Pupils explore abstract shapes and space, develop skills in constructing 3D objects, and understand the difference between 2D and 3D art.

Computing: T-Shirt designer

They'll learn about graphic design and use digital tools to create their own unique designs. Through hands-on activities, they'll express their creativity and develop their digital design skills.

Science:

In "How Does Your Garden Grow?" this term, Year 3 will learn about plant functions, water absorption, reproduction, and nutrient collection. Through scientific enquiry, they'll explore plant questions using methods like observation, fair testing, and research. They'll record detailed observations using diagrams.



Spanish: Days of the week/month.

Learn and say numbers 13 to 31. Memorize the months of the year. Answer "What month is it?" in Spanish. Recognize and say dates. Ask and answer "When is your birthday?" in Spanish.
