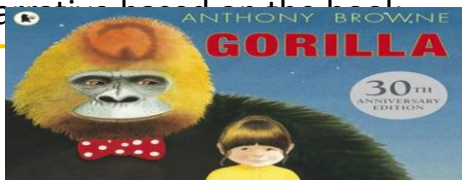


English:
