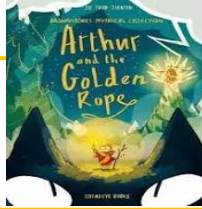


English:

The children will visit Kirkby Leisure Centre for a 2 week block of swimming lessons. They will also engage in weekly dodgeball sessions

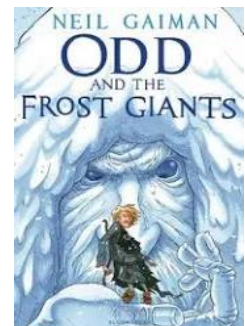
Art
