Science: Growing seeds and bulbs

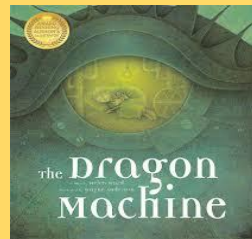
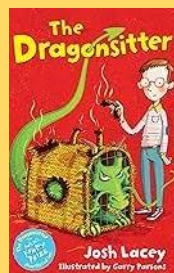
Children will learn about germination, the differences between seeds and bulbs and the conditions plants need to grow.
