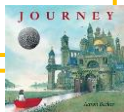


## English:

"Journey" by Aaron Becker is a captivating wordless picture book that sparks children's imaginations through stunning illustrations. With no text, it prompts them to create their own narrative, develop character descriptions, invent dialogue, and write descriptive narratives. It's a wonderful tool for fostering creativity and storytelling skills in young readers.



## History:

This half term, Year 3 children will explore the impact of the Roman Empire on Britain. They'll investigate Emperor Claudius' invasion, compare Roman settlements with Celtic villages, learn about Boudicca's rebellion, and explore the final years of Roman rule. Through this study, they'll gain insights into how the Romans influenced Britain's culture, society, and history.



## Maths

This term in Maths, Year 3 will be exploring fractions and time. Through practical activities, they'll learn to recognise, find, and compare fractions, as well as tell the time to the nearest minute. Pupils will apply their understanding to real-life contexts, helping them see how these skills are used every day.

Athletics/Gymnastics

Art- Abstract shape & space  
This unit focuses on teaching pupils how to transform 2D card shapes into three-dimensional structures and sculptures. Pupils explore abstract shapes and space, develop skills in constructing 3D objects, and understand the difference between 2D and 3D art.

Computing- Keyboard Adventures. This term in Computing, Year 3 will take part in Keyboard Adventures, learning to use both hands to type with more speed and accuracy.

## Science

In "How Does Your Garden Grow?" this term, Year 3 will learn about plant functions, water absorption, reproduction, and nutrient collection. Through scientific inquiry, they'll explore plant questions using methods like observation, fair testing, and research. They'll record detailed observations using diagrams.



Spanish- In Spanish this term, Year 3 will explore the topic "Where do you live in Spain?" They will learn how to say where they live and discover key facts about Spanish cities and regions. The topic also includes learning about Spanish culture, traditions, and daily life in different parts of the country.
