- Communication and Interaction: intensive interaction, attention autism, Gestalt Language Processing, Lego/brick therapy, and/or sensory circuits
- Candidates should be suitably qualified and have experience of working with pupils with Social, Emotional and Mental Health: relevant training related to adverse childhood experiences (ACEs), sensory circuits, anxiety, and/or emotional regulation.
- Cognition and Learning: executive functioning, dyslexia, dyscalculia, accredited CPD with a specific English or Mathematics intervention, working memory and/or multi-sensory teaching approaches.
