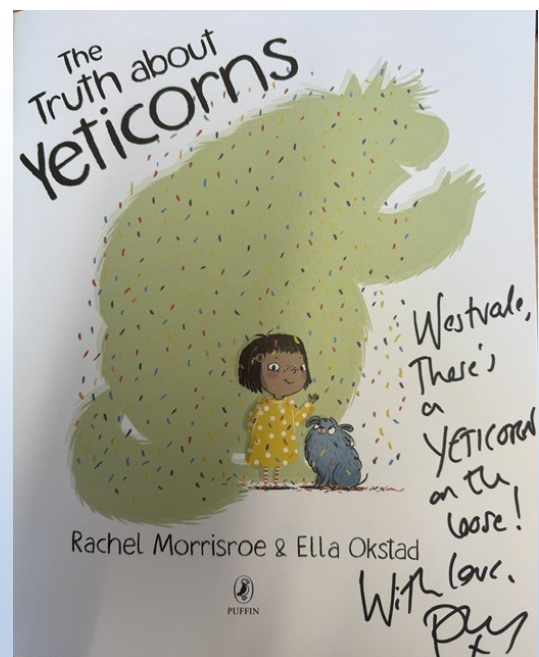
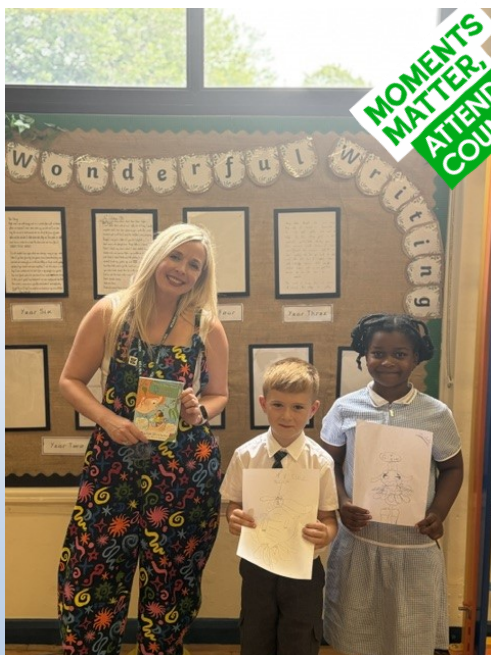
Author Visit—Rachel Morrisroe
